## TEN COMMANDMENTS

- I. Thou shalt not have strange gods before me (God is entitled to our exclusive and complete obedience in everything)
- II. Thou shalt not take the Lord's name in vain (God, Almighty, Lord, Jesus Christ, Holy Ghost, any euphemism-"gosh", etc.)
- III. Keep the sabbath holy
  (Cease from labor and devote the day to the Lord in prayer and thanks)
- IV. Honor thy father and thy mother
  (Hold in high esteem, love and reverence; God promises life for those who obey this command)
- V. Thou shalt not kill (commit murder)

  (Not all killing is wrong, animals for food, death penalty by civil authorities, killing by "just" wars, and accidental deaths is not murder or intentional killing.)
- VI. Thou shalt not commit adultery

  (The act of intercourse with a woman not his wife is a sin, as well as even looking at another woman, not his wife has already committed adultery by lust. This is impurity and sinful.)
- VII. Thou shalt not steal

  (Actual stealing by taking what does belong or even coveting something not ours)
- VIII. Thou shalt not lie or bare false witness
  (Sin of the tongue causing another the loss of reputation by gossip behind ones back)
- IX. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house (Not just the actual taking something that does not belong to us, but the covetous desire of)
- X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife (Similar to commandments VI, VII, and IX in seriousness.)
